

Explore Point Roberts and uncover its remarkable past!

Discover the stories that shaped Point Roberts! Follow the Point Roberts History Trail, a self-guided journey to more than 30 historic sites across the peninsula. Along the way, interpretive plaques reveal the people, places, and events behind this truly one-of-a-kind community.



- 1 Border** - Access by foot and bicycle from Tyee Road.
- 2 Monument Park** - 2 Markers.
 - Boundary Marker #1. The signs detail the complex engineering and physical challenges surveying the international U.S.-Canada border line along the 49th parallel in the mid-1800s.
 - History of Smuggling
- 3 International Market Place** - There is one marker located at the right entrance to the market. "Where Everyone Knew Your Name".
- 4 The Reef** - Multiple markers to the left of the front door.
 - Breakers,
 - A Regional Music Hub
 - Former Front Door To Point Roberts
 - Economy Powered By Alcohol
 - Where The Community Gathered"
- 5 Yellow Cannery Building**- 2 historical markers at the driveway to the old cannery.
- 6 Community Center**- 2 historical markers:
 - Salmon Canning
 - Educating in an enclave
- 7 Lighthouse Marine Park**- 2 historical markers:
 - George's Cannery, early shipping history, the old lighthouse that once stood here,
 - Historic Chinese immigrants who worked the canneries during the Chinese Exclusion Act era.

- 8 Marina Parking Lot**- Historical marker of a Seafarer's Haven located by the flag pole.

- 9 Church Parking Lot**- 2 historical markers:
 - South Beach
 - Where the Faithful Gather
- 10 Water's Plat**- 2 historical markers:
 - South Beach
 - Where the Faithful Gather

- 11 Cemetery**- 2 historical markers:
 - World War II
 - Icelandic Heritage

- 12 Baker Field** - An outdoor space for all.

- 13 Lily Point** - Find several interpretive signs and markers throughout the marine reserve.
- 14 Lily Point** - Multiple historical markers: Middens, Whalen Family, Crab Town, and more.
